

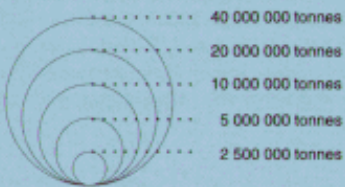

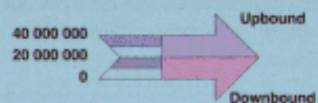

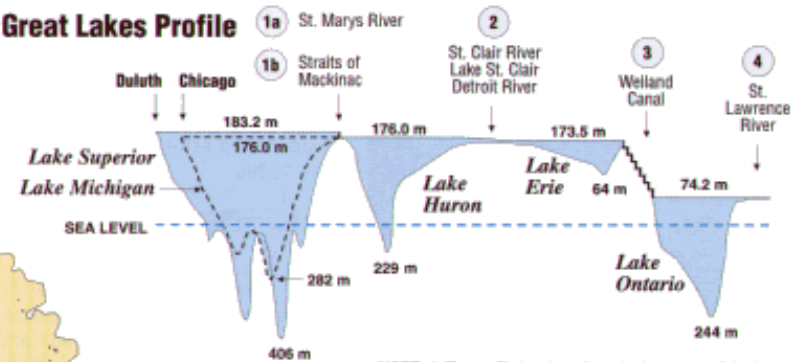

INTER-LAKE COMMODITY FLOW IN TONNES, 1990

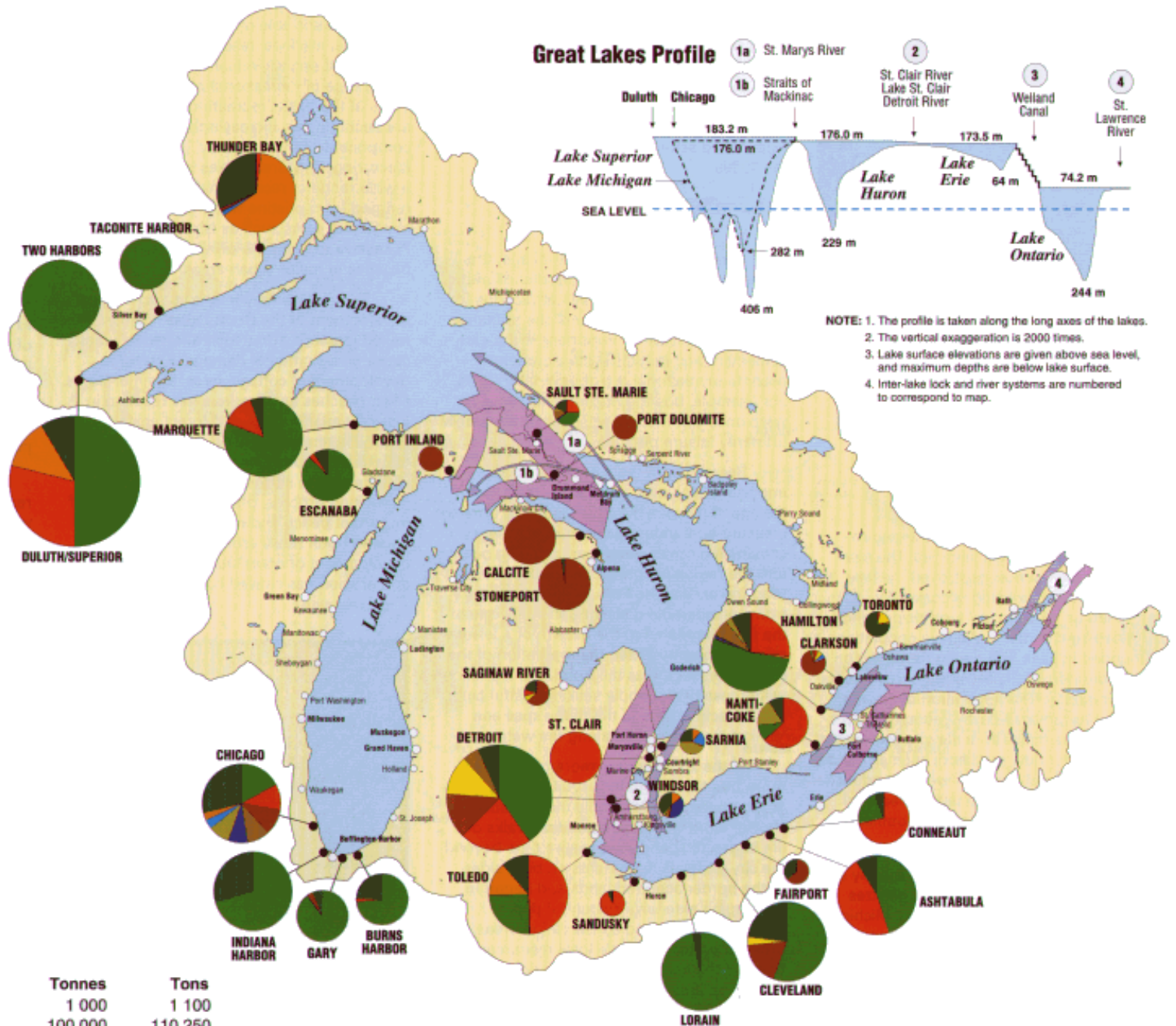
